

Follow the Money ...

Chronic conditions consume 78% of US total healthcare spend

For the public sector, they account for 96 cents per dollar on Medicare, 83 cents per dollar on Medicaid

Individuals with a chronic condition require a \$6,032 spend annually - 5x that for individuals without such a condition
