
#### Job Growth (in FTEs)





#### Gross Revenue












#### Which healthcare services do you think/know are available?
















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#### New, Last Month... A New Goal and Extended Clinic Hours



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## Consider outcomes are you already measuring in your practices or systems.

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#### Now divide that data by race.

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## Then, ask "Am I okay with these disparities?"

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## Improving Health Equity: Some Practical Steps Within the Health System

Check the facts about the adequacy of primary health care capacity in service areas.

Critique proposed models of healthcare delivery in disadvantaged communities by asking whether we would settle for them if they were options being planned for us or our families.

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## Improving Health Equity: Some Practical Steps Within the Health System

Examine the membership and embedded power relationships of every committee we are asked to join. If it is about migrant health, is it chaired by a migrant person? If if it about rural health, what are the zip codes of everyone around the table?

Ask if another epidemiological project or descriptive report is really necessary. Do we already know enough? Can we already track improvements were they to occur?

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## Improving Health Equity: Some Practical Steps Within the Health System

Interrogate the role of applied research: should we ever randomize the disadvantaged to interventions already accessible to the affluent?

Insist on a timeline for a change in health outcomes at a population level for a community we care about. Specify the target difference, propose a timeline, be willing to be held to account, and set an example by working diligently to target in daily practice.

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## Improving Health Equity: Some Practical Steps Beyond the Health System

Learn something specific about socioeconomic conditions:

Indigenous history of the neighborhood

Number of babies born into poverty

Presence of affordable/livable housing

Availability of sidewalks, parks, and walking paths

Rules for unemployment and disability payment schemes

Socioeconomic indexes by zip code

Develop a personal position on a minimum wage policy

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## Improving Health Equity: Some Practical Steps Beyond the Health System

Examine the presence of government, faith community efforts, and other social services in areas with high unemployment

Trace the money flow in every allocation of public resources. How are the marginalized affected?

Challenge every social idea. Is this the best we can do?

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## Addressing macro problems begins with micro solutions.

Find a temporary way to fund the right thing (grants, philanthropy, etc.)

Measure outcomes and costs (overall cost per patient) related to that intervention.

If successful, share the stories and data with the people who hold the purse strings.

Repeat.
