




#### BINGE DRINKING


30% of adults in Dodge and Jefferson county report binge drinking once in 30 days or heavy daily drinking.




**OBESITY**



- Began with a small group of volunteer community leaders in February 2014 in response to the 2013 Dodge and Jefferson Healthier Community
   Partnership's Community Health Needs Assessment
- Formed 4 sub-groups:
  - Healthy Eating
  - Walking/Biking Trails
  - Healthy Challenges
  - Public Awareness



# BLUE ZONES PROJECT DODGE COUNTY

- **2013** 
  - Dodge Jefferson Healthier Communities Partnership Community Health Needs Assessment
  - Blue Zones Project first on our radar
- **2014** 
  - Healthy Communities Healthy Lives Coalition Formed
- **2015** 
  - Blue Zones Project assessment and coalition building
- **2016** 
  - Dodge County joined the Blue Zones Project movement
  - Created a team of 6 individuals to lead Dodge County through the movement
- **2017** 
  - BDCH goes through validation process to be the 1st approved worksite 66% of employees pledged participation (565 pledges signed)
  - BDCH Café goes through validation process to be the 2nd approved restaurant






